



Reston Town Center strives to provide a safe and enjoyable experience to everyone visiting the property. This Code of Conduct is enforced at all times. Those violating this Code of Conduct may be requested to leave the property. Reston Town Center is private property.

While at Reston Town Center the following activities are not allowed:

The use of obscene or sexually explicit language, obscene gestures or racial, religious or ethnic slurs.

Physically or verbally threatening any person.

Disruptive conduct that is disorderly or which unreasonably annoys, obstructs, interferes or endangers others. This includes: noisy or boisterous activities, loud music, throwing objects, running, skating, skateboarding, rollerblading, loitering or interfering with the free flow of pedestrian or vehicle traffic.

Bicycles must be parked in the bicycle racks located throughout the property.

Disrupting the shopping enjoyment of customers, or disrupting the intended business use of the center.

Any form of solicitation, sales of products or services, or distributing handbills, leaflets, commercial advertising or promotional material of any kind or offering samples of items which are sold, available for sale or available in exchange for a donation or contribution without prior written permission of management.

Engaging in any unlawful activity or behavior is prohibited. This includes possessing any open container of alcohol anywhere except in businesses licensed to sell alcoholic beverages, public intoxication and/or possession or being under the influence of illegal drugs.

Discarding litter anywhere on the property, except in designated trash receptacles as well as rummaging through or removing items from trash receptacles.

Defacing, damaging, destroying or removing any real or personal property constituting part of or located in or on the property. This includes writing, spraying, scratching or otherwise affixing graffiti on such property.

Overnight parking; parking in parking areas other than designated parking areas, parking in fire lanes or other no parking areas, erratic or careless driving, exceeding the posted speed limit, or use of a vehicle in manner inconsistent with property traffic markings or signage. Parking violators are subject to towing at the vehicle owner's expense.

Photographing, videotaping and filming the interior or exterior of the property for any purpose without prior written consent of property management.
